Successful candidates may get an AHF International High Performance Goal Keeper Training & Coaching Course certificate. Excellent candidates may get also a Recommendation to FIH Academy High Performance Coaching Course.

The Asian Hockey Federation are very pleased to announce **AHF International High Performance Goal Keeper Training & Coaching Course 14-16 March 2018** which will be held alongside the Men's Asian Games 2018 Qualifier Muscat , Oman 8-17 March 2018.

We would like to express our gratitude for the kind hospitality and the support from Oman Hockey Association in organizing this important event.

The course will be organized jointly by the Asian Hockey Federation & Oman Hockey Association will run over four days, from the evening of Tuesday 13 March and morning to close late Friday 16 March.

FIH Senior Coach Carel Van Staak from The Netherlands and FIH top experts will conduct the course with Tayyab Ikram, FIH Master Coach, leading the course as Course Director.

The aim of the AHF is to provide a simplified education structure and resource for nations and continents to be able to develop Goal Keeper coaches from grass roots through to a high performance / international level. All nations will have the opportunity to access the programme pathway at an appropriate level.

Applicants should be an independent B2+ English speaker

Qualification:

- Be nominated by your own National Federation or call directly by Continental federation
- Have appropriate knowledge, skills and experience about the Goal Keeper
- Goal Keeper Coaches of National, international clubs & National top teams
- National team Goal Keepers and Goal Keeper of International clubs
- Have a genuine interest in wanting to develop himself/herself as Goal Keeper coach
- Hold experience of presenting information to Young & Elite groups
- Adopt an interactive rather than lecturing approach
- Be open-minded, adaptable to change, welcome feedback and be willing to self-reflect
- Agree to deliver a specified number of training days per year (2 per year as a minimum)

Desired Outcomes

- Certification of up to 20 AHF International High Performance Goal Keeper Training & Coaching Course
- Opportunity for entry into or advancement in the FIH Coach Certification and accreditation system.
- Participation Certificate, for all other situations

Course Detail-

Participation fee 500 USD

- **Payment Terms and Condition:**

Immediately following the acceptance of an application for attendance on a course, the participation fee will be due full, there will be no reimbursement in case of withdrawal from the course for any reason, unless a suitable /eligible replacement is found who pays the full fee.

Application Now Open

Only invited National Hockey Associations (NAs) affiliated to the FIH may nominate a maximum of **2 Goal Keeper Coaches or Players** to apply for the participation in the Training & Coaching Course. Applicant must meet the entry criteria below, which must be evident from information provided on the application. Application must be received before **the Saturday 10th Feb 2018**.

NAs are asked to provide an order of priority if applying for more than two coaches or Players. AHF WILL INFORM THE NAs status of their applications, as some may, regretfully not be accepted where a large number of application are received.

Selection Process.

The selection aims to select only the most highly experienced and qualified applicants. National representation is also considered with an aim to give the course as wide an Asian mix as possible
