The Event forms part of the Asian Hockey Federation Development, Coaching and Education Program 2019

The AHF and SHF is initiating a series of educational programmes. The will be conducted/presented by FIH Top Qualified Expert former olympian, FIH Coach, FIHA Trainer and Educator Mr. Tai Beng Hai fo Malaysia

The aim of the **FIHA- AHF** is to provide a simplified education structure and resource for nations and continents to be able to develop coaches, officials and managers from grass roots through to a high performance / international level. All nations will have the opportunity to access the programme pathway at an appropriate level.

Course will be conducted in English

Qualification:

- Be nominated by your home Federation or call directly by Continental federation AHF
- Have appropriate knowledge, skills and experience about the game
- Have a genuine interest in wanting to develop himself/herself as coach
- Hold experience of presenting information to Young groups
- Adopt an interactive rather than lecturing approach
- Be open-minded, adaptable to change, welcome feedback and be willing to self-reflect
- Agree to deliver a specified number of training days per year (2 per year as a minimum)

Desired Outcomes

- Certification of up to 20 FIHA-AHF Level 2 Coaches
- Recommendation to FIH Hockey Academy Level 3 Coaching Course, if they are assessed as Competent at this course
- Participation Certificate, for all other situations.



Course Detail

- Participation fee 400 USD
- **Payment Terms and Condition:**

Immediately following the acceptance of an application for attendance on a course, the participation fee will be due full, there will be no reimbursement in case of withdrawal from the course for any reason, unless a suitable /eligible replacement is found who pays the full fee. Included the fee

Application Now Open

Only invited National Hockey Associations (NAs) affiliated to the AHF may nominate a maximum of 2 coaches to apply for the participation in the Coaching Course. Applicant must meet the entry criteria below, which must be evident from information provided on the application. Application must be received before **8 August 2019**. NAs are asked to provide an order of priority if applying for more than two coaches. AHF WILL INFORM THE NAs status of their applications, as some may, regretfully not be accepted where a large number of application are received.

Visa Requirements

Applications for visas should be dealt with at least a month prior to the arrival date. The Host NA will provide all necessary information and assistance to the teams who will travel to Singapore. Possession of a valid visa alone does not guarantee entry into Singapore. The period of stay granted will be shown on the visit pass endorsement given on your passport and it will not be tied to the validity of your visa.

Accreditation Card

Any request for accreditation card must be made a month before arrival. Access to the venue and to restricted areas within the venue will be controlled to ensure that any restricted areas are only accessed by suitably accredited personnel.
