Hero Asia Cup 2022, commencing on 23 May, to take place in Jakarta

Jakarta (Indonesia), 20 April 2022: The Hero Asia Cup will be held from **23rd May to 1st June 2022** in **Jakarta, Indonesia**. This was announced by the Asian Hockey Federation (AHF) today. The **Indonesia Hockey Federation (FHI)** will be the host of the tournament.

The final dates and match schedule of Hero Asia Cup 2022 have been approved by the International Hockey Federation (FIH).

The 11th edition of the quadrennial event will take place at GBK Sports Complex Hockey Stadium, Jakarta, Indonesia. Host nation Indonesia will be participating in Asia Cup for the first ever time and will go head-to-head with India, Pakistan, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Bangladesh and Oman for the title.
